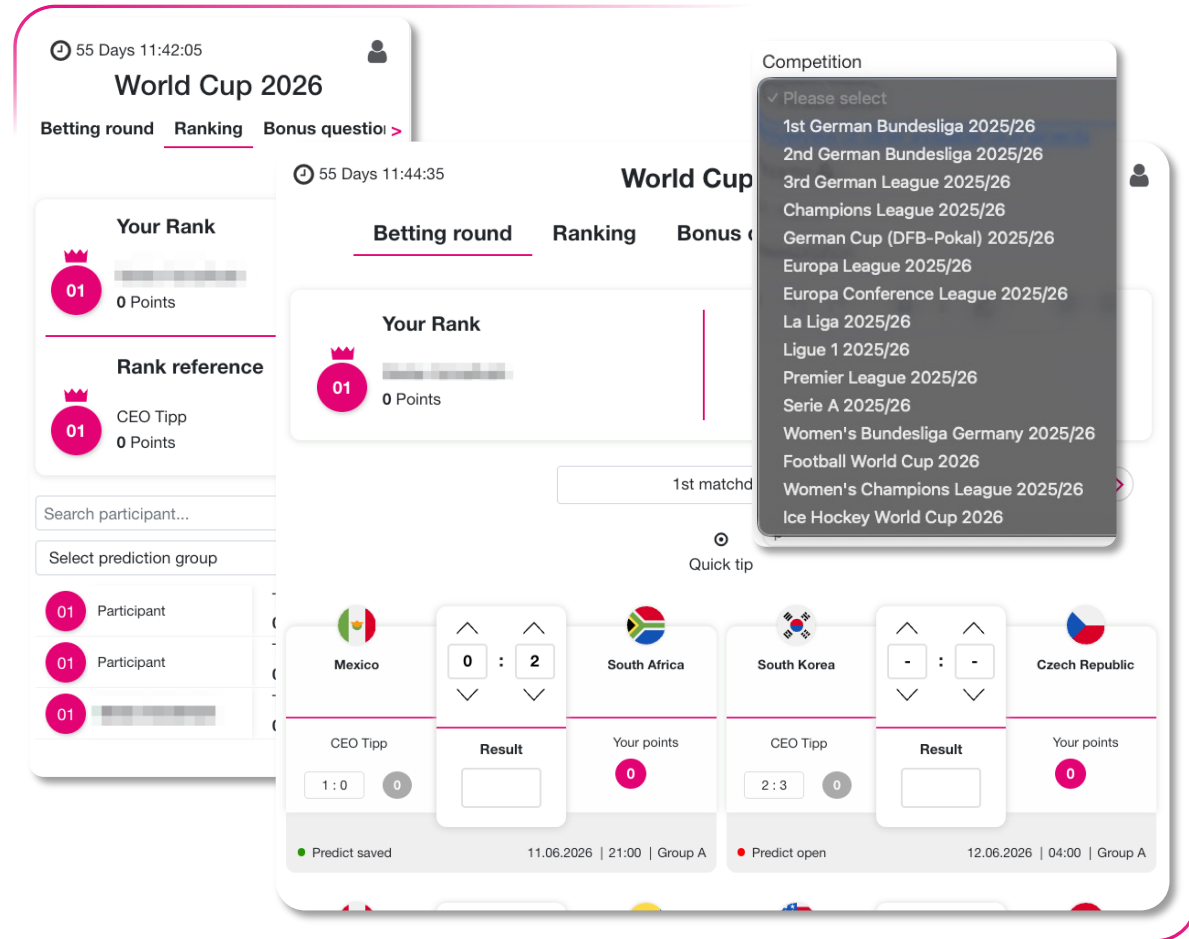
## Use Case

Increase intranet usage and create a lively working atmosphere – with a game that gets everyone involved!

## Features

- **Seamless integration:** Integrate the plugin directly into your staff app or intranet – for a seamless user experience – without the need for an extra password!
- **Quick setup:** Ready to go straight away, even with large numbers of participants.
- **Real-time results:** Automatic live updates keep the excitement going.
- **Predictions and bonus questions:** Add result predictions and bonus questions (e.g. top goalscorer), including a reminder function for predictions not yet submitted – for even more fun.
- **Leaderboards, prediction groups and top tipsters:** Foster a competitive spirit with leaderboards and prediction groups – anonymised if desired.

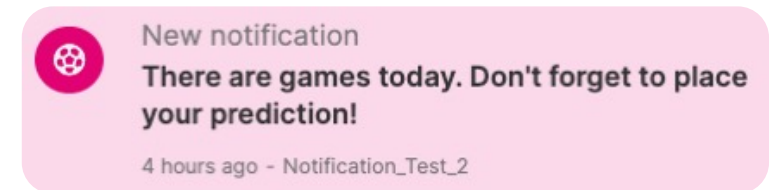
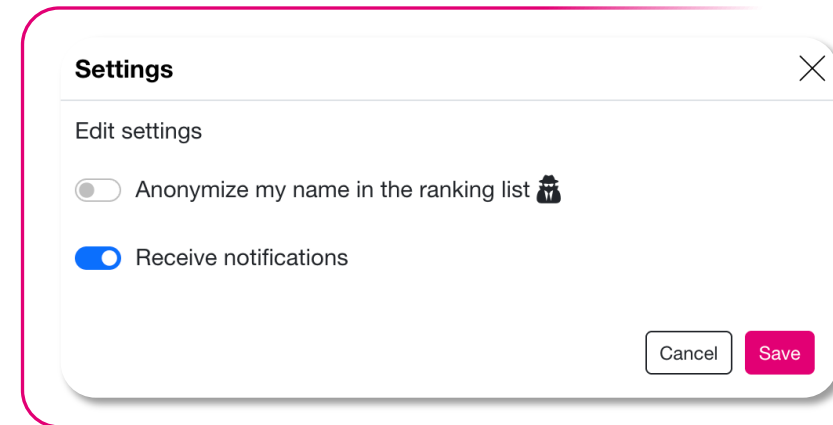
# Notifications for placing predictions.

With the new extension, users can be **reminded of outstanding prediction submissions via system notification.**

This way, you ensure a higher participation in the prediction challenge and facilitate internal communication around the match days.

Details:

- Automatic notifications with a direct link to the respective prediction round or to the prediction round
- Flexible setting of sending times by the editors of the prediction round
- Users can choose to enable or disable these reminders in their settings; **by default, notifications are disabled for each user**




# Random predictions.

With the new "Random predictions" feature, users can have the **prediction fields for games automatically filled with random values** if they wish.

This makes it much easier to place bets, especially for many games.

- The function is optionally available for every prediction round via the **quick prediction menu**.
- When used, the predictions are randomly generated and adopted.
- The predictions can still be adjusted manually.

**Note:** Predictions previously submitted for individual matches will be overwritten by using this feature.

# Transferring predictions to other rounds.

With this new feature, users can now choose to use their saved predictions in multiple prediction pools within a corporate platform. This is particularly important for companies that run various prediction pools simultaneously at both global and local levels.

**Participants can thus easily transfer a prediction set they have already created to other prediction rounds without having to re-enter their predictions.**

- Makes it easier to participate in several concurrent prediction rounds
- Saves time when submitting predictions by reusing previously saved predictions
- The feature is optional and can be used as required

**Note:** Predictions can only be transferred within the same corporate platform and for prediction rounds of the same tournament type.

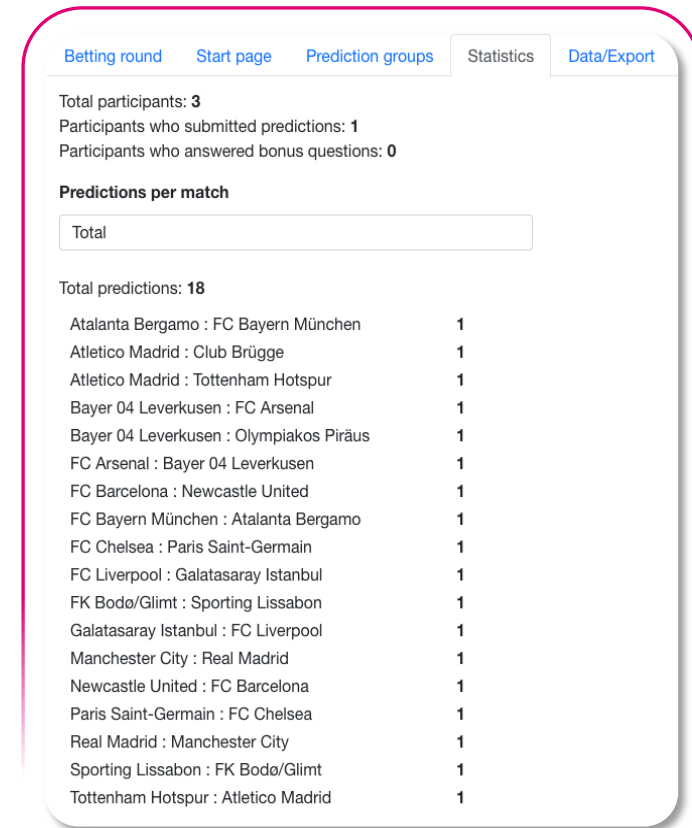
# Participation statistics at a glance.

With the new 'Statistics' tab, editors can now gain detailed insights into participants' prediction behaviour.

This allows you to analyse how many predictions have been submitted for each match – both in a clear overview for all matches in a competition and specifically for each match day.

This makes it possible to track participation rates transparently throughout the tournament and assess activity within the various prediction rounds. As a result, you can see at a glance where participation is particularly high or where there is still potential for additional communication.

# Hide inactive users in leaderboard.

Thanks to this adjustment, only those users who actively participate in the prediction challenge and have already placed predictions will be visible in the ranking. Accounts that only have access to the prediction challenge but have not yet become active will no longer appear in the overview.

- The ranking remains clearer and leaner.
- Relevant comparisons are possible at a glance without being distracted by inactive profiles.
